Describe the branches.

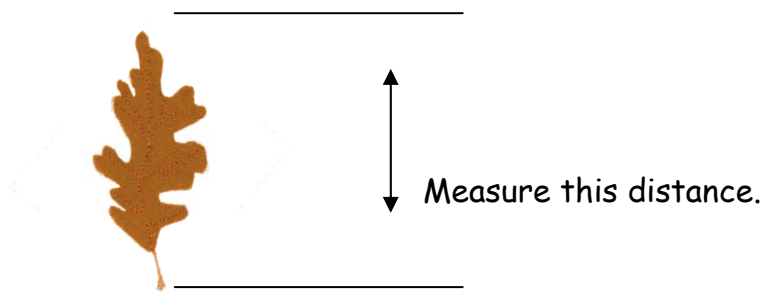
Tree Measurements

Circumference of a Tree: Take a piece of string and wrap it around the trunk of the tree and the widest place. Mark the string or cut it. Use a ruler or yardstick and measure the length of the string. Record it below. You just found the circumference of the tree.
